

The 2026 Australian Persimmon Industry Conference and Field Day event is heading to Toowoomba.

As Queensland's largest inland city, Toowoomba is perched on the top of the Great Dividing Range in the heart of one of Australia's most productive food bowls and showcasing a growing urban culture. Toowoomba's economy has long been rooted in agriculture and is now considered the best performing agricultural region in Queensland. To the west, the Darling Downs is one of the richest agricultural areas in Australia, producing a wide variety of crops such as cotton, wheat, barley and sorghum, and intensive production of beef cattle, pigs and poultry. To the east, the Lockyer Valley is known as Queensland's "Salad Bowl" because of its significant vegetable and fruit production, and most importantly, persimmons!!

The Venue

OAKS TOOWOOMBA HOTEL, 22 Annand Street, Toowoomba, 4350

The conference will be held at the Oaks Toowoomba Hotel, conveniently located in the heart of Toowoomba. This modern venue offers both conference facilities and on-site accommodation, all within walking distance from restaurants, cafes and bars. It is only a short 8-minute walk away from Queens Park and 25-minute drive from the Toowoomba Airport. Delegates are welcome to choose from a variety of nearby accommodation options.

For convenience, the Oaks Toowoomba Hotel provides rooms within the same building as the conference venue. Accommodation options include a choice of standard hotel rooms and two or three-bedroom options. All rooms are equipped with a microwave, kettle, air conditioning and a flat-screen TV.
